
This letter is to confirm our conversation of July 22, 1981 regarding our co-development of the Encyclopedia Britannica Proposal - the proposal of which Britannica is providing remuneration to you for its development (see attached letter dated June 30, 1981), we agreed that:

1. In terms of fiscal matters, you will serve as the contact with Britannica;
2. The fee for the proposal will be divided equally between yourself and the Nebraska ETV Network, each of us receiving a \$5,000.00 fee for the work accomplished;
3. You will reimburse the Nebraska ETV Network for our portion of the fee (\$5,000.00) in one payment upon completion and acceptance of the proposal by Encyclopedia Britannica, currently due for delivery on or about October 1, 1981; and
4. You will reimburse the Nebraska ETV Network for out-of-pocket expenses over and above the \$5,000.00, a final accounting for which will be provided to you within sixty days of the final delivery and acceptance of the proposal by Encyclopedia Britannica.

If you agree to the above, please sign and date where indicated and return the original to me (please keep the enclosed copy for your files).

Bob, it goes without saying that I'm very excited about this project. Let's hope that this is only the beginning of a fine relationship.
